

REMINDERS FOR CITY OF PANHANDLE LANDFILL

Water bill with current address must be presented as proof of residence to use the City Landfill. Anyone outside the City of Panhandle within precinct #2 or #3 may obtain a landfill permit from City Hall for an annual fee plus landfill charges determined by Landfill Operator.

**Hours of operation 9:00 to 4:30
Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday**

Weather permitting

Closed on observed holidays

Fees are determined by Landfill Operator at time of disposal.

The following items are **NOT ALLOWED** at the Panhandle Landfill

Tires

Batteries

Fuel

Oil

Filters

Freon

Acids

Shingles

(Except with Roofing Permit and proof of special landfill charges paid-per square)

Paint

(no wet chemical/hazard chemicals)

Please contact **City Hall @ 537-3517** to determine what should be done with these items.

Items that can be taken to the landfill FREE of charge

Tree limbs and brush (no wood)

Trunks and limbs separated

All metal (must be segregated)

Appliances (white goods)

Refrigerators must be evacuated and tagged by a certified technician

Also, please refrain from putting **furniture or appliances** in dumpsters, these large or heavy items make it difficult for our refuse truck to work properly and may cause damage to the truck.

These items should be taken to the landfill for disposal.
